Isaiah 58·1-12

The Lord says, "Shout out loud. Don't hold back. Shout out loud like a trumpet. Tell the people about the things they have done against God. Tell the family of Jacob eat. But do you think this is what about their sins. Then they will come every day looking for me. And they will want to learn my ways. They will become a nation that does what is right. They will obey the commands of their God. They will ask me to judge them fairly. They will want God to be near them. They say, 'To honor you we had special days when we gave up eating. But you didn't see. We humbled ourselves to honor you. But you didn't notice." But the Lord says, "You do what pleases yourselves on these special days. And you are unfair to your workers. On these special days when you do not eat, you argue and fight. You hit each other with your fists. You cannot do these things as you do now and believe I will listen to your prayers. This kind of special day is not what I want. This is not the way I want

have done. I don't want people just to bow their heads like a plant. I don't want them to wear rough cloth and lie in ashes to show their sadness. This is what you do on your special days when you do not the Lord wants?

"I will tell you the kind of special day I want. I want you to free the people you have put in prison unfairly. Undo their chains. Free those to whom you are unfair. Free them from their hard labor. I want you to share your food with hungry people. I want you to bring poor, homeless people into your own homes. When you see someone who has no clothes, give him yours. Don't refuse to help your own relatives. If you do these things, your light will shine like the dawn. Then your wounds will quickly heal. Your God will walk before you, and the glory of the Lord will protect you from behind. Then you will call to the Lord, and the Lord will answer you. You will cry out to the Lord, and he will say, 'Here I am,' "You should stop making trouble for others. You should stop using
