Appointment of Rev. Liz Hull




After a long period of uncertainty over the future ministry at St. Thomas', I am pleased to announce the appointment of the Rev. Liz Hull as our Priest in Charge. Liz is currently serving a curacy in the Rushen Group of parishes, and will be licensed to St. Thomas' by Bishop Peter on Tuesday 5th October, at 7.30pm, with her first Sunday on 10th October.

As most of you will know, there are plans afoot to create a Team Ministry comprising of the three Douglas parishes of St. Thomas, St. George, and St. Matthews. As and when this happens, Liz will then be designated Team Vicar, working in conjunction with the Team Rector, who will be both vicar of St. George's and Archdeacon of Mann. With the departure recently of the Ven Andie Brown, this position is currently vacant. Please note this does not mean the parishes are merging; each one retains its own distinct identity, and although Liz will have regular contact with the Team Rector, the Bishop has made it quite clear that her prime responsibility will be for St. Thomas'. Please pray for Liz and her family as she prepares now to come to us and lead the parish into the future.




Churches Bookshop
